



TEEN DRIVER CONTRACT



Realizing the awesome responsibilities and inherent dangers of driving the family cars, I hereby agree to the following conditions in exchange for this great joy and privilege:

- ___ 1. I will always ***without exception*** wear my seatbelt.
- ___ 2. I will always make sure that ***everyone*** in our car is wearing his or her seatbelt.
- ___ 3. I will never carry ***more passengers than there are seatbelts*** in the car.
- ___ 4. I will never allow ***anyone else to drive*** our car.
- ___ 5. I realize that because there are fewer cars in the family than there are drivers, ***I must not take the car without permission.***
