The declaration is:

Response: I give witness to your declaration and you are now united under the Texas marriage laws.

Couple can also exchange rings during the declaration. You will have the opportunity to say your own words/vows during the ring exchange.

Declarations can be scheduled from 9:15 am – 4:00 pm by appointment only and based on availability. Appointments can be made up to 30 days from the requested date.

Please no photography or video recording during the declaration. You may use the courtroom afterwards to take pictures if you wish.

Appointments will not be scheduled until the following acknowledgement is turned into the office and the \$100.00 cash fee is paid.

Please be on time for your scheduled appointment. If your appointment is not cancelled or rescheduled in advance, or you do not come at your scheduled time, your fee may be forfeited.
