33 New COVID-19 Cases in Denton County

May 28, 2020 – Denton County Public Health (DCPH) has announced 33 new laboratory-confirmed cases of COVID-19 in Denton County. This increases the cumulative, countywide total to 1,318 confirmed COVID-19 cases. DCPH is also reporting 23 newly recovered cases of COVID-19.
