Denton County reports Second Positive West Nile Virus Mosquito Trap

June 30, 2017 - Denton County Public Health (DCPH) is reporting a second positive West Nile Virus (WNV) mosquito trap located north of the previously reported positive trap. The second positive WNV trap is located in unincorporated Denton County northwest of Hackberry.

DCPH will conduct expanded truck-based ground spraying in the area located near the positive WNV mosquito traps beginning Friday, June 30, 2017. Please see amended dates that spraying will take place. Pending favorable weather conditions, the expanded ground spraying schedule is as follows:

- Friday, June 30 between the hours of 9pm and 5am
- Saturday, July 1 between the hours of 9pm and 5am
- Sunday, July 2 between the hours of 9pm and 5am
