PUBLIC HEARING NOTICE MUSTANG ROAD AND COFFEY ROAD TRUCK RESTRICTIONS

Pursuant to Texas Transportation Code §251.152, Notice is hereby given that the Transportation and Engineering Department of Denton County will hold a Public Hearing to consider regulatory sign placement for Mustang and Coffey Road.

The Transportation and Engineering Department recommends the adoption of regulations establishing a Truck restricted traffic zone for Mustang and Coffey Roads, Denton County maintained, in accordance with Texas Transportation Code Chapter 251, Subchapter E, specifically consisting of "No Truck" and "No Thru Truck" zones and signs posted for specific portions of Mustang Road and Coffey Road, located in Denton County Commissioner Precinct #1, to-wit: (1) a "No Thru Truck" zone for Mustang Road starting 2900' East of FM 2931 and extending to FM 1385; and (2) a "No Thru Truck" zone for Coffey Road starting at Mustang Road and heading South to FM 428. Emergency Services and local deliveries should be exempt from the restriction.

Mustang Road and Coffey Road are located in the north east corner of Denton County Commissioner Precinct #1. Construction traffic using Mustang Road currently creates safety concerns to the traveling public and generates more road miles of travel for both on and off system roads. Signage and restrictions are intended to improve coordination and connectivity between State and Local truck routes. To reduce costs to the public, improve public safety and to better coordinate Off-System County maintained roads with State On-System roads, the Denton County Department of Transportation and Engineering proposes: (1) a "No Thru Truck" zone for Mustang Road starting 2900' East of FM 2931 and extending to FM 1385; and (2) conjoining "No Thru Truck" zone for Coffey Road starting at Mustang Road and heading South to FM 428. Emergency Services and local deliveries should be exempt from the restriction. Additionally, violators would be subject to fines not to exceed \$200 per Texas Transportation Code Chapter 251.161.

The Public Hearing will be held during the regularly scheduled Commissioner's Court in **1 Courthouse Drive, Denton, Texas on Tuesday, November 30, 2021 at approximately 9:00 am**. For more information, please contact the Department of Transportation and Engineering, at (940) 349-3410.
