County Commissioners Court honors employees

Denton County – Four individuals were recognized Tuesday in Denton County Commissioners Court for being among the top county employees.

Julie Carriker, a medical investigator with Denton County Public Health, received the John A. Scott Award as the 2018 Employee of the Year. In addition to her current role, Julie also represents the county on the Board of Directors for the American Board of Medicolegal Death Investigations and is the chair on their Continuing Education Committee. She is a clinical director for the Medical Reserve Corps in Denton County, serves as a contractor for all county law enforcement and serves as volunteer medical staff in the Dallas 9/11 Stair Climb.

Other finalists recognized include: LaDon Jones, who has worked in the County Clerk's Office since August 2000; Maryanne Lobo, who has worked in the Technology Services Department since October 2003; and John Williams, who has worked for the Vehicle Maintenance Department since July 2009.

The John A. Scott Award was named after a former Denton County employee who was tragically killed in a plane crash. The award was created in 1998 to honor the former Director of Facilities Management.

“We are honored to recognize our employees’ dedication and commitment as well as the memory of John A. Scott,” said Denton County Judge Mary Horn. “Our 1,700-strong work force is dedicated to serving the people of Denton County.”
