

Compliance Dismissals - \$10 Fee

Justice of the Peace, Precinct 4 of Denton County, Texas

You must submit the required documentation and remit the \$10 dismissal fee no later than the appearance date on your ticket.*

Offense	Required Documentation
Driving with Expired License	Proof of license renewal.
Violate Driver License Restriction	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Proof that the restriction or endorsement was imposed: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. because of a physical condition that was surgically or otherwise medically corrected before the date of the offense; or b. in error and that fact is established by the defendant. <p>OR:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 2. Proof that the Department of Public Safety removed the restriction or endorsement before the due date on your ticket.
No Driver License	Copy of license appropriate for the type of vehicle driven and valid at time of offense.
Fail to Change Address or Name on Driver License	Proof that license has been updated with the new address and/or name.
Failing to Display Registration Insignia on Vehicle	Affidavit affirming that the registration insignia is now correctly displayed on vehicle, and that registration was valid at time of offense.
Wrong, Fictitious, Altered, or Obscured Insignia	Affidavit affirming that valid registration insignia is now correctly displayed on vehicle, and that registration was valid at time of offense.
Driving With an Expired Motor Vehicle Registration	Copy of receipt from tax office showing registration renewal for that vehicle AND payment of the delinquent registration fee (penalty fee) to the tax office. (*Remedy within later of 20 working days or appearance date.)
No License Plate or Fail to Display Two Plates	Affidavit affirming that the license plate(s) is now correctly displayed on vehicle, and that registration was valid at time of offense.
Wrong, Fictitious, Altered or Obscured License Plate	Affidavit affirming that the license plate(s) issued for that vehicle is now correctly displayed on vehicle, and that registration was valid at time of offense.
Operating a Vehicle that is not Properly Equipped	Affidavit affirming that the defective equipment has been corrected (does not apply to commercial vehicles), or receipt specifying equipment repair, vehicle and date.
Unauthorized Glass Coating Material	Affidavit affirming that the window tint has been removed (does not apply to commercial vehicles).
Operating or Giving Permission to Operate a Vessel Without a Valid Certificate of Number	Proof that certificate has been renewed within 10 working days from the date of the offense. The certificate must not have been expired for more than 60 days.

Compliance Dismissals - No Fee

You must submit the required documentation or request (1) within 10 days of the offense, or (2) no later than the appearance date on your ticket.

Offense	Required Documentation
Failure to Provide Evidence of Financial Responsibility (No Insurance)	Proof of coverage of defendant in that vehicle at the time of the offense. Your agent will be contacted to verify.
Failing to Have a Photo ID and Identification Card and either: (1) a boater identification card issued by the department, or (2) proof of completion of the requirements to obtain a vessel operator's license issued by the US Coast Guard.	Copy of photo ID and identification card that was valid at the time of the offense, or Request submitted not later than the 10th day after the offense for permission to take a boater education course.
Failing to Display Required Hunting License	Copy of required license that was valid at time of offense.
Fails or Refuses to Show Fishing License or Tag on Request	Copy of required license or tag that was valid at time of offense.
Failing to Possess the Required Hunter's Education Certificate	Request submitted not later than the 10th day after the offense for permission to take a hunter safety training course.
Fails or Refuses to Show Proper Trapping License	Copy of a proper license that was issued to you and valid at the time of the offense.
